Through the establishment of The Megan Schulman Pediatric Vascular Anomalies Clinic, K. Hovnanian Children's Hospital will be home to the only multidisciplinary vascular anomalies program for infants, children, teenagers and adults in central New Jersey. While many vascular anomalies do not affect the day-to-day life of a child, there are some complex conditions that require a team of dedicated specialists to provide expert care and treatment. From common birthmarks to rare tumors, this clinic will be the best place to get the information, treatment and care for the children in New Jersey and beyond.

The Megan Schulman Pediatric Vascular Anomalies Clinic at K. Hovnanian Children's Hospital will serve several vital purposes:

1. **Specialized Care:** The clinic will provide specialized care tailored to the unique needs of pediatric patients with vascular anomalies. This includes comprehensive evaluation, diagnosis, treatment, and ongoing support for patients and their families.
2. **Multidisciplinary Approach:** We aim to bring together a team of experts, including pediatric surgeons, interventional radiologists, dermatologists, hematologists, and nurses, to collaborate in the care of these patients. This multidisciplinary approach ensures that each child receives the most appropriate and comprehensive care plan.

For the third year in a row, *U.S. News & World Report* ranked Joseph M. Sanzari Children's Hospital at Hackensack University Medical Center and K. Hovnanian Children's Hospital at Jersey Shore University Medical Center **#1 in New Jersey and top 10 in the Mid-Atlantic Region.**

At the heart of our pediatric network, K. Hovnanian Children's Hospital at Hackensack Meridian *Health* Jersey Shore University Medical Center is one of a select group of state-designated children's hospitals in New Jersey, and the first and largest in Monmouth and Ocean counties. At our core, we're 300 community pediatricians, obstetricians, and family practitioners working side-by-side with the region's largest group of pediatric subspecialists.

K. Hovnanian Children's Hospital is also part of the Children's Hospital Association, an organization that is one of the nation's premier voices for children's hospitals and champions policies to support the highest quality care for kids in our communities.

Our state-of-the-art facility, includes a pediatric emergency care center, a specialty care center, a pediatric acute care unit with private patient rooms, and neonatal and pediatric intensive care units to take care of critically-ill patients.

The Trad Family Trauma Center at Jersey Shore University Medical Center has been designated as a Level II Pediatric Trauma Center by the American College of Surgeons. Jersey Shore University Medical Center is the only hospital in Monmouth and Ocean counties, and the eastern part of New Jersey, to earn this elite designation. It is one of only three hospitals in the state with Level II Pediatric Trauma Center certification.

In 2018, Jersey Shore University Medical Center opened the HOPE Tower on its east campus. This 10-story facility houses an array of pediatric outpatient programs and services encompassing the building's entire 5th floor including gastroenterology, endocrinology, pulmonology, infectious diseases, neurology, nephrology, hematology and oncology.
